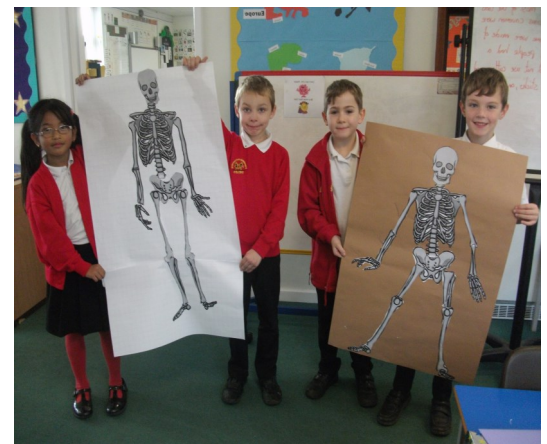
Winter Wonderland

This week, we were lucky enough to have a visit from The Dog's Trust who came to speak to the children in their assemblies. They gave lots of information about how to stay safe around dogs.

Lily-Ella and Tilly from Year 3 explained what they learned:

We learned lots of rules to keep safe. First, if we see a dog and we wanted to stroke it, we must always ask the owner first.

The second rule is to stand tall and straight like a guard for 3 seconds and let the dog sniff you.

The last rule is to ask the owner where the dog likes to be stroked and to only stroke the dog in that place.

Another interesting fact is to remember to stroke the dog with the back of your hand not the palm of your hand.

If you are afraid of dogs and a dog runs up to you, you should never run but instead stand still and use the 'X Factor' (Crossing your arms across your body).

Don't pick dogs up as they don't enjoy being cuddled.
