Dear Parents and Carers,

We are fortunate enough to be visiting Paradise Wildlife Park as part of our "Crazy Creatures" topic on Tuesday 10th July.

The trip will provide children with a wide range of experiences, allowing them the opportunity to learn about different animals such as tigers and monkeys and attend shows about different creatures.

We will be leaving school at 9:15am and will be travelling by coach. Your child will need to either bring a packed lunch or pre-order a school packed lunch. Please ensure that all home packed lunches are in a labelled carrier bag and include a drink (no glass bottles or cans please). Please ensure that your child has a bottle of water so they remain hydrated throughout the day. If the weather is warm children will need to bring extra water.

We will be back at school by the end of the day ready for collection as normal at 3:15pm. Your child will need to wear suitable footwear for walking around the park. Please ensure that children have sun cream applied and a sun hat with them if the weather is warm or a coat if the weather is colder.

We request your support with a voluntary contribution of £17.50 to cover the costs for this trip. We are always grateful for your contribution to your child's education, which ensures trips like this can take place and consequently enhance your child's learning. If voluntary contributions do not cover the cost of a trip it may have to be cancelled. Any concerns please contact our Finance Officer, Mrs Hoskins, to discuss this in confidence. To confirm your child's place could you please log into your Schoolcomms account via the gateway www.Schoolgateway.com, where you will be able to give your consent and pay for the trip. Please give your consent and make payment by the 30th June.

Giving your consent online saves you the need to fill out permission slips and also confirms the following:

- I understand my child will be travelling in a coach
- I confirm that the school has all current medical and contact details

It is school policy that children have to demonstrate a high standard of behaviour at all times, in order to represent the school. The offer of a place for any school trip is dependent on your child's behaviour; a child's place may be withdrawn at the discretion of the head teacher.
