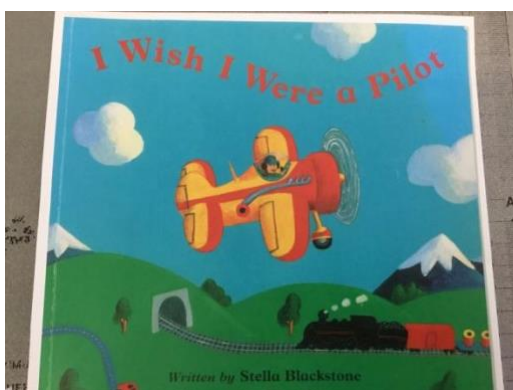


Summer term 1
