Please note that tutoring is not part of the School Clubs program and must be arranged separately.

For After School Clubs, individual letters will be sent via the School Gateway, and places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Once your child has signed up for a club, they are expected to attend every week. You must inform the Club Leader if your child will be absent or no longer wishes to attend. Please also ensure that your child is collected promptly at the end of the session.

It is school policy that children must demonstrate a high standard of behaviour to attend clubs. The offer of a club place may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Club Leader or Headteacher/Deputy Headteacher if this standard is not maintained.

We kindly ask parents to check that their child genuinely wishes to attend before signing up, as the expectation is that once enrolled, children commit to attending for the full duration of the club. Please also be mindful of other clubs taking place on the same day to avoid scheduling conflicts. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

As places are limited, clubs will continue to operate on a first-come, first-served basis.
