Dear Parents and Carers,

Last week, I met with the School Council to explore why only 90% of our parents felt that their children were happy at The Leys (please note that previous Parent-surveys have been above 90%).

The School Council discussed this with their classes and summarised that the main concerns relate to friendships, particularly during lunchtime in the winter months. Although the School Council recognises that the school has improved play provision with more resources and equipment, issues around "taking turns, speaking with respect, and valuing other viewpoints" remain a matter of concern.

We then discussed possible solutions and ways to address these issues. The School Council felt that we need to further explore the "School of Kindness" approach in classes, reinforce playground rules, and re-empower our peer mentors.

Over the coming weeks, class teachers will continue to explore this matter with pupils under our school values of respect, inclusivity, and empathy.

The SENDCo of the school (Mrs Pomroy) and other members of the SEN team continue to attend extensive training relating to SEN. The Leys have two staff members with the National SENDCo award.

✓ The school has 2 Herts therapeutic thinking trainers who undertake annual training and ensure all staff receive updated Hertfordshire's therapeutic thinking training each year. This covers ACES, mental health, de-escalation and the management of children with challenging behaviour. ✓ Staff also have training in the following: ✓ EKLAN ✓ level 5 and 7 training in both assessing and teaching children with dyslexia ✓ First Aid - including Anaphylactic Shock, Epilepsy and Asthma ✓ Level one and two mental health training ✓ ELSA training ✓ Autism trust level 1,2 and 3 ✓ Access to the national college ✓ ✓ Attachment aware ✓ Relational practice ✓ Supporting independence ✓ SCERTs and Making communication happen


