Your help required

We are always thinking of new ways to raise our profile, raise funds and create fantastic events for our children. To this end we would like to ask if any of you can help us in the following ways:

Match Funding – if you work for an organisation that operates a match funding scheme, please do let us know. This scheme allows companies (often larger organisations like banks, retailers, insurance) to support PTAs through a charitable donation by financially matching what is raised at events. We will send out a more detailed communication about this later in the year but please do ask your employer if they have this scheme as it is a very easy way for us to double funds raised!

Music – if you have a budding musician or other performer (dance, gymnastics, baton twirling etc!) please let us know as we need this kind of entertainment from time-to-time at events. We also love to have group performances at the Summer Fair so please ask

the dance/gym etc teacher to contact us). If you have experience or equipment for discos, sound, microphones etc please let us know.

Raffle prizes – we need great prizes for our raffles at the Summer Fair plus sometimes at other events. If you are able to donate any prizes we are always very grateful. This can be gift items, vouchers, food, drink, toys etc.

Online shopping -We need your help! If you shop online, please could you sign up to easyfundraising to support The Leys Primary School Stevenage?

It's a really easy way to raise money for us – you just use the easyfundraising site to shop online with more than 3,500 well known online stores like Amazon, Argos, John Lewis, ASOS, Booking.com, eBay, Boden, and M&S and when you make a purchase, the retailer sends us a free donation, at no extra cost to you.
