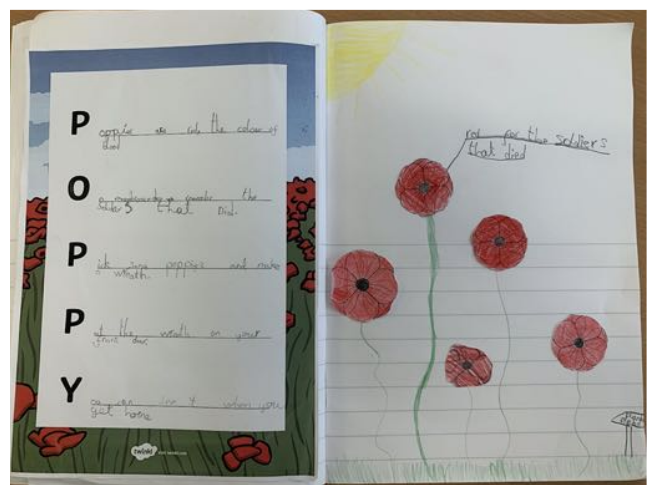


CLASS of the WEEK Ahlberg

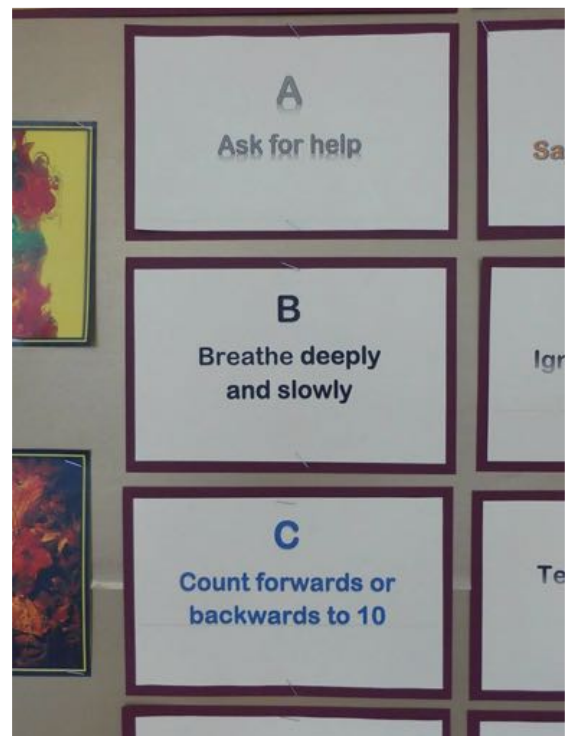
