



## School Uniform & PE kit Reminder

Dear Parents/ Carers,

We're two thirds of the way through our school year, summer is fast approaching. However, although we still have a few months to go before the end of term, I can see our school uniform is not as consistent as it was in the autumn term.

Can I therefore please remind you to send your child to school wearing the correct school uniform until we break up in July. Please see table below for details:

Black shoes or plain black trainers can be worn, brightly coloured fashion trainers should not be worn. Pupils may wear boots to school in winter and pupils may wear trainers in the playground, however they must change back into black school shoes/ trainers when they go back into class.

Wearing the correct school uniform is school policy: it also creates an identity for school and is an important part of being a school pupil.

We have some barely worn school uniform items available for any children that don't already have them - these are available free of charge. If you would like additional sweatshirts or cardigans or support in purchasing uniform items, please contact the school office.

Thank you for your support, ensuring school policies are followed and making sure your child is dressed appropriately for school each day. We will allow you until May half term to make further purchases if needed.
