Over half a million people in the UK are severely affected by mental illness. But it's not just what's going on in their minds that makes life hard...it's what's going on in ours. One of the most difficult things about living with a mental illness can be the judgement of others.

Over a third of UK adults say they wouldn't feel comfortable in the presence of someone they believe is experiencing severe mental illness. Three in five people living with a mental illness say the fear of how others perceive them has stopped them seeking support.

Let's Rethink, is a campaign to tackle the unfair stigma and the discrimination that people face at work, in school and at home around their mental health.

Is your child due to start Nursery or Reception in September 2025?

If your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 you must apply to start an infant or primary school (Reception class) in September 2025. The closing date for Reception class applications is 15 January 2025. You must still apply for a Reception place, even if you already have a place in the Nursery associated with your preferred school.
