The Leys School is dedicated to providing an inclusive and supportive environment for all children, regardless of their personal circumstances or background. We understand that some children, due to early life experiences, may require additional support to thrive academically and emotionally.

In line with our statutory duty, we have a Designated Teacher, Mrs. Barr, who acts as the key point of contact for our

previously looked after children and their families. Mrs. Barr's role is to ensure these pupils receive personalised learning support and to champion their individual needs, promoting their achievement and well-being. If your child was previously in the care of a local authority and is now with you through adoption, a Special Guardianship Order, or a Child Arrangements Order, please contact Mrs. Barr to discuss their needs and the support available.
