PE Kit 2026 - 2027

This academic year (2026 - 2027), we are promoting the importance of PE Kit within our school. Children should bring a full PE Kit to school on their PE days (including swimming days if applicable). This is vital because:

- It will raise the profile of PE in school to put more clearly in children's minds the importance of sport and leading a healthy active lifestyle.
- Extra PE could be taught throughout the week.
- To show equality amongst all pupils.
- Correct kit including footwear will reduce the risk of injury during sporting activities and also help improve performance levels.

The PE Kit here at The Leys is as follows:

- Plain White T-Shirt
- Plain Red or Black Jumper/Fleece (School jumper/fleece/cardigan is acceptable)
- Plain Black Shorts/Black Jogging Bottoms
- Sports Trainers/Plimsolls

- No Jewellery - including earrings and necklaces (stud earrings must be taken out or covered with tape prior to coming to PE)
- No leggings/gym tights are to be worn
- No boots/school shoes are to be worn
- All shoulder length hair or longer must be tied back

All uniform should be named to ensure pupils can reclaim their items.
