It is school policy that children must demonstrate a high standard of behaviour in order to attend clubs. The offer of a place in a club may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Club Leader or Headteacher/Deputy Headteacher, if this high standard is not maintained.

Please could parents ensure that their child wishes to attend the club, as the expectation is that once signed up they commit to coming for the period of time that the club runs for. Also, take note of other clubs taking place on the same day to avoid clashing. Your help with this would be much appreciated. Places are limited, therefore we will operate by first come -first serve.
